



Recipe for Success Foundation's farmers marKIDS curriculum provides children and facilitators with knowledge and tools to transform their garden produce into a campus farm stand to serve the surrounding community, while gaining food and financial literacy through experiential learning.

Using a free, downloadable farmers marKIDS toolkit with five lesson plans, students will develop financial literacy, entrepreneurial skills and business experience, while making fresh produce easily accessible to the surrounding neighborhood. Educators, parents and



community groups can use the targeted lessons provided to prepare students to run their very own farm stand. The curriculum culminates in a farmers marKIDS stand, when students apply the skills and concepts they've learned to operate a stand selling the produce grown in their school, community or home garden.

Students can use the toolkit to guide their efforts in harvesting and pricing produce, developing and promoting advertisements and executing their farmers marKIDS stand anytime they choose.

- Teaches children the business of food and value of fresh produce and shopping locally.
- Introduces students to marketing and advertising techniques used to persuade food consumers, thus helping them be savvy food buyers.
- Provides lessons in financial literacy, such as budgeting, pricing and profit.
